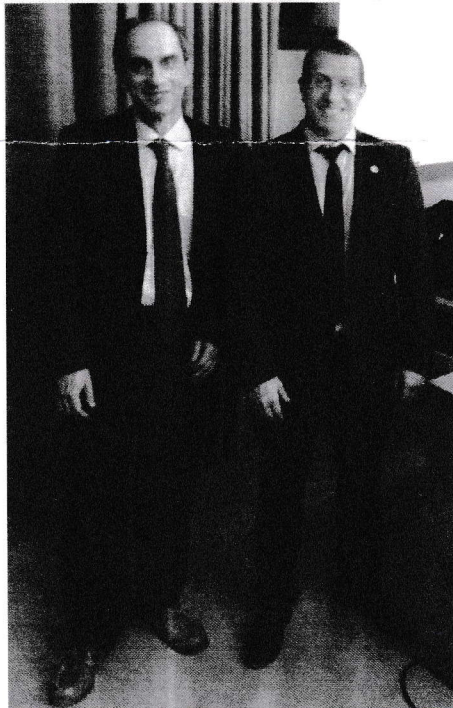
94th EOS Congress, Edinburgh U.K.
