EOS ANNUAL CONGRESS 2024 – ATHENS, GREECE

We look forward to welcoming members and colleagues from around the world at the **99th Annual Congress in Athens, Greece, from 9th-13th June**, under the Presidency of Professor Demetrios Halazonetis.

Over 800 abstracts have been submitted on several areas of research. 310 submissions were received for oral presentations, and 62 have been accepted for inclusion in the scientific programme, following a blind review by the Scientific Committee. All accepted abstracts' authors have been notified.

It promises to be an excellent congress, with high-quality scientific sessions, 15 esteemed [keynote speakers](#), over 600 scientific and clinical posters, and an exhibition of a wide range of orthodontic and dental products, as well as new technological developments in orthodontics. Professor Athanasios Athanasiou will deliver the prestigious Sheldon Friel Memorial lecture on Tuesday 11th June.

THE DISTINGUISHED TEACHER AWARD LECTURE

The Distinguished Teacher lecture was given by Professor Theodore Eliades (Switzerland), on 23rd February 2024, on "**Lessons not learnt from the introduction of new materials in Orthodontics: the case of aligners and 3D printing**". The lecture was live streamed and available on demand for the two following weeks. The lecture was attended by 260 postgraduate students.
