GRANTS AND AWARDS

EOS Research Grants

Eleven applications for grants were received in 2024. The research committee met, with four grants being awarded to Alejandro Iglesias Linares (Spain), Padhraig Fleming (Ireland), Despoina Koletsi (Switzerland), and Edwin Ongkosuwito/Von den Hoff (Netherlands).

Grants for 2025 (up to £30,000) will be available and members are encouraged to prepare applications. The deadline for submissions will be 31 December 2024.

W J B Houston Scholarship

The Scholarship for 2024 was awarded to Spyridon Papageorgiou (Switzerland) for the research paper on: "In vitro and in vivo investigation of the effect of juvenile rheumatoid arthritis on the response of human periodontal ligament to mechanical stimulation".

This prestigious award is usually offered once every three years. The scholarship was not awarded during the COVID 19 pandemic, and we are therefore able to advertise this award for 2025.

The Scholarship for 2025 is available for junior EOS members, up to a maximum of £90,000.00 - i.e.£30,000.00 per annum - (or the equivalent in Euros), payable for a period of three years. Please send submissions by the 31 December 2024.

NB: For the Houston Scholarship and EOS Research Grants, applicants must have been a member of the EOS for a minimum of two consecutive years at the date of application in order to apply.
