GRANTS AND AWARDS

W J B Houston Scholarship

This scholarship is now available for junior EOS members, up to a maximum of \pounds 90,000.00 - i.e. \pounds 30,000.00 per annum (or the equivalent in Euros) - payable for a period of three years.

EOS Research Grants

The EOS is pleased to announce that sums between \pounds 5,000.00 and \pounds 20,000.00 (or the equivalent in Euros) are now available to members for research.

NB: For the Houston Scholarship and EOS grants, applicants must have been a member of the EOS for <u>a minimum period of two consecutive years</u> at the date of application in order to apply.

Lingual Award

We have great pleasure in announcing a new award sponsored by DW Lingualtechnik that will be available at the end of 2021. The award is for €500,000.00 (€50,000.00 per annum for a period of 10 years). The award is available for either a prospective research project involving lingual orthodontics or articles already published in relevant orthodontic journals. In the latter case the prize will be for the best three papers. Applications are invited from both EOS members and non-members.

Councillors – Call for Applications

The period of office of the three present EOS Councillors, Ivo Marek, Pertti Pirtiniemi and Andreu Puigdollers, will expire in June 2022. Applications are invited for these three positions from active members in European countries that will not be represented on Council after June 2022. All proposals must be accompanied by letters of support from four active members of the Society, one from a member in the nominee's own country and three from active members in three different European countries. The nomination must be signed by the nominee and include a brief curriculum vitae. In the event of there being more than three applications a ballot will be held.

President 2028 – Call for Applications

Applications are invited for the position of President for 2028 from active members in European countries. All proposals must be accompanied by letters of support from four active members of the Society, one from a member in the nominee's own country and three from active members in three different European countries.

The nomination must be signed by the nominee and include a brief Curriculum Vitae. In the event of there being more than one application a ballot will be held.

In the light of recent financial issues, those wishing to stand for President and organise a congress on behalf of the EOS must provide a financial bond of €50,000. This will be returned following a successful conference.

The closing date for all applications is the 31 December 2021
